## Goals of the initiative:

- 1) Improve and stimulate the sensuous and expressive side in our youth
- 2) Promote self-understanding as a mechanism to liberate the latent potential

## The idea of the initiative:

As educators working in the mainstream pedagogical field, we are fully aware that schools with its current format is a grade "factory". Meaning the working process involves "transferring" information and lacks the educational side that enables a student to do self-search and face his "weaknesses" and realize his strengths and .

This system also fails in developing dialogue skills and dealing with the different "other", as this side is not important for a process where the "grade" is the center of everything. Additionally, "transferring" information does not require self-expression and from here stems our initiative that proposes reconsidering the priorities and comes up with an alternative educational space where the student can go through a

process where he can learn through dialogue with his peers, where he can develop self-expression skills and enhance his ability to deal with others. It will also develop communication skills
